Applications will be judged competitively by a team of experienced arts educators on the quality of individual portfolio submissions. Students may apply for more than one award. More than one award may be awarded in each category depending on the number and quality of submissions. We regret that at this time international students are not eligible.

SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

The **Jack Shadbolt Multiple Arts Excellence** award is available to a graduating student who has demonstrated excellence in two or more of the Visual and/or Performing Arts disciplines (*ie. visual art, music, dance, or film & theatre*) and is planning to continue his/her education in the arts.

The **Robert Bateman Future Teacher** award is available to a graduating student who has demonstrated excellence in Visual Arts and is planning to pursue a teaching career in the field of Elementary or Secondary Education.

The **North Shore Community Foundation -Gordon Smith Outstanding Visual Artist** award is available to a graduating student who has demonstrated excellence in the Visual Arts and is planning to continue his/her education in the Visual Arts. (*visual arts include traditional media as well as photographic and digital media*)

Evaluation Criteria:

Scholarship applications and supporting material will be evaluated on:

- artistic ability, achievements and personal objectives in the arts
- caliber of the work in comparison to other students at the same level of study in the same discipline
- the quality of the presentation for this application
- incomplete submissions will not be considered.
